Ruth Loyalty 1:16 And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God.

- 1 Samuel Last judge, first king 8:5 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations.
- 2 Samuel David's reign 7:16 And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established forever.

Nehemiah Rebuilding 2:17 Then said I unto them, Ye see the distress that we are in, how Jerusalem lieth waste, and the gates thereof are burned with fire: come, and let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach.

Esther Faith in action 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy fathers house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?

Job Suffering 19:25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the lager day upon the earth.

Psalms Praise 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

Proverbs Gods wisdom 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Ecclesiastes Mans wisdom 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

Song of Solomon Human and divine love 2:4 He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.

Isaiah Promised Messiah 53:11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Jeremiah Warnings and promises 33:3 Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

Lamentations Weeping and wailing 3:22---23 It is of the Lords mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

Ezekiel Judgment and glory 37:27-28 My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And the heathen shall know that I the Lord do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.

Daniel Rise and fall of kingdoms 2:21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding.

Hosea Redeeming love 2:19 And I will betroth thee unto me forever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

Joel Day of the Lord 1:15 Alas for the day! for the day of the Lord is at hand, and as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come.

Amos Gods justice 5:24 But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream.

Obadiah Edom's doom 15 For the day of the Lord is near upon all the heathen: as thou hast done, it shall be done unto thee: thy reward shall return upon thine own head.

Jonah Gods mercy 3:10 And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.

Micah Judgment and restoration 6:8 He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

Nahum Nineveh's doom 1:7 The Lord is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.

Habakkuk Doubt to faith 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Zephaniah Gods wrath 2:3 Seek ye the Lord, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the Lords anger.

Haggai Rebuild the temple 1:8 Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the Lord.

Zechariah The coming Messiah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Malachi Repentance 3:7 Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the Lord of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return?

Matthew Christ the King 16:15-16 He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Mark Christ the servant 10:45 For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

Luke Christ the man 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

John Christ, the Son of God 20:30-31 And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: but these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

Acts The early church 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Romans The Gospel 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

- 1 Corinthians Christian conduct 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians Christian righteousness 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Galatians Christian liberty 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Ephesians Christian standing 2:8---9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast.

Philippians Christian joy 2:2 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

Colossians Preeminence of Christ 1:17-18 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

- 1 Thessalonians Return of Christ 4:16-18 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
- 2 Thessalonians Stand firm 2:15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.
- 1 Timothy Leadership 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.
- 2 Timothy Endurance 3:16-17 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Titus Encouragement 2:11-13 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ.

Philemon Forgiveness 14 But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly.

Hebrews Christs sufficiency 4:14-16 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

James Living your faith 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

- 1 Peter Suffering and glory 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
- 2 Peter Faithfulness of Christ 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us---ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- 1 John Fellowship 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 2 John Steadfastness 5 And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another.

Jude Keep the faith 3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.
